ABSOPULSE Electronics Ltd is dedicated to supporting our customers regarding strict environmental standards. We comply with European RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances) and REACH (Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemical substances) Regulations. Requirements are constantly reviewed to ensure compliance to the most recent version of both regulations. Additionally, we support many customer defined programs.

On 22 August 2012 the US Securities and Exchange Commission issued a final ruling to implement the disclosure requirements known as Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act or “Conflict Minerals”.

ABSOPULSE Electronics Ltd. is not the direct issuer to the SEC, but we are fully committed to the elimination of “Conflict Minerals” in the supply chain, compliance to the applicable requirements of the OECD due diligence guidance on conflict minerals and manufacturing fully compliant products for our customers.

ABSOPULSE Electronics Ltd. has a policy to use materials that have come from smelters on the EICC / GeSI audit list. Absopulse Electronics Ltd. is working with its suppliers to ensure they comply with this policy and that no “Conflict Minerals” – including gold, tin, tantalum and tungsten are in any of its products whenever it is possible.
